Application Procedure

Apply to UW-Stout using the UW System Application form available from your Student Services Office or online at <http://apply.wisconsin.edu> . In addition, we will need a copy of your final high school transcript (if you have not already earned your Associate Degree) and an official transcript from all post-secondary institutions where you have earned college credit. If you took any Advanced Placement tests while in high school and received a score of 3 or higher, a copy of your score report is required to earn college credit. Transferring directly from any of the UW Colleges the \$35 application fee is not required.

Admissions Requirements

Students indicating Family & Consumer Sciences Education will be admitted as a [pre-education major](#) at UW-Stout. "Pre-Education" is the initial designation for all students interested in being a certified teacher through one of our education majors.

All students wishing to transfer into a teacher education program must have a 2.75 cumulative GPA. Subsequent acceptance into a teacher education major and enrollment in professional education coursework will require successful completion of the Pre-Professional Skills Test. Therefore, it is highly recommended that the PPST be taken prior to enrolling at UW-Stout. PPST registration information can be found at the [School of Education](#) website.
