

Interpreting Course Listings

Course Identification System

Stout uses a subject/number course identification system. Example: ENGL-320. The alpha-abbreviation identifies the subject area; see the listing below. The three digits refer in part to the level of the courses.

Courses at the 100 to 400 level may be taken for undergraduate credit only; 500 to 600 level are graduate credit only and have a "paired" undergraduate course identification at the 300 to 400 level; 700-800 level courses are graduate level only. Please read all footnotes carefully.

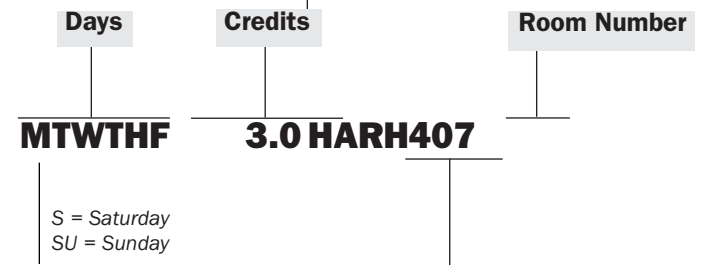
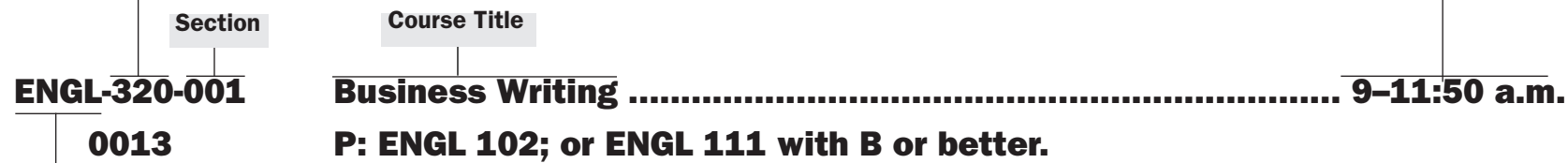
Course offerings, meeting times and instructors are subject to change as resources and needs indicate.

Class Hours

Classes are 55-minutes with a 10-minute break between classes, and 85 minutes with a 15-minute break between classes. When preparing your schedule, check to be sure that no class meeting times overlap.

Credits

One credit hour usually represents one hour of class time per week plus two hours of out of class study.
